Schools requiring Estyn monitoring following Section 28 inspection

As you know, a team of inspectors, led by Maldwyn Pryse, HMI, visited your school recently in order to monitor the progress made since the Section 28 inspection in April 2013.

Outcome of the monitoring visit

Ysgol Dyffryn Trannon is judged to have made good progress in respect of the key issues for action following the Estyn visit in June 2014. We will now remove the school from the list of schools requiring Estyn monitoring. There will be no further Estyn monitoring visits in relation to this inspection.
